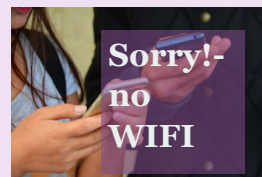
The evening meetings and Sabbath morning including Sabbath School, will be livestreamed.

Please note that due to liability issues, non-medical staff cannot provide medical care for you.

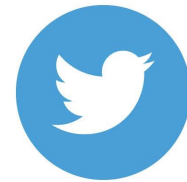

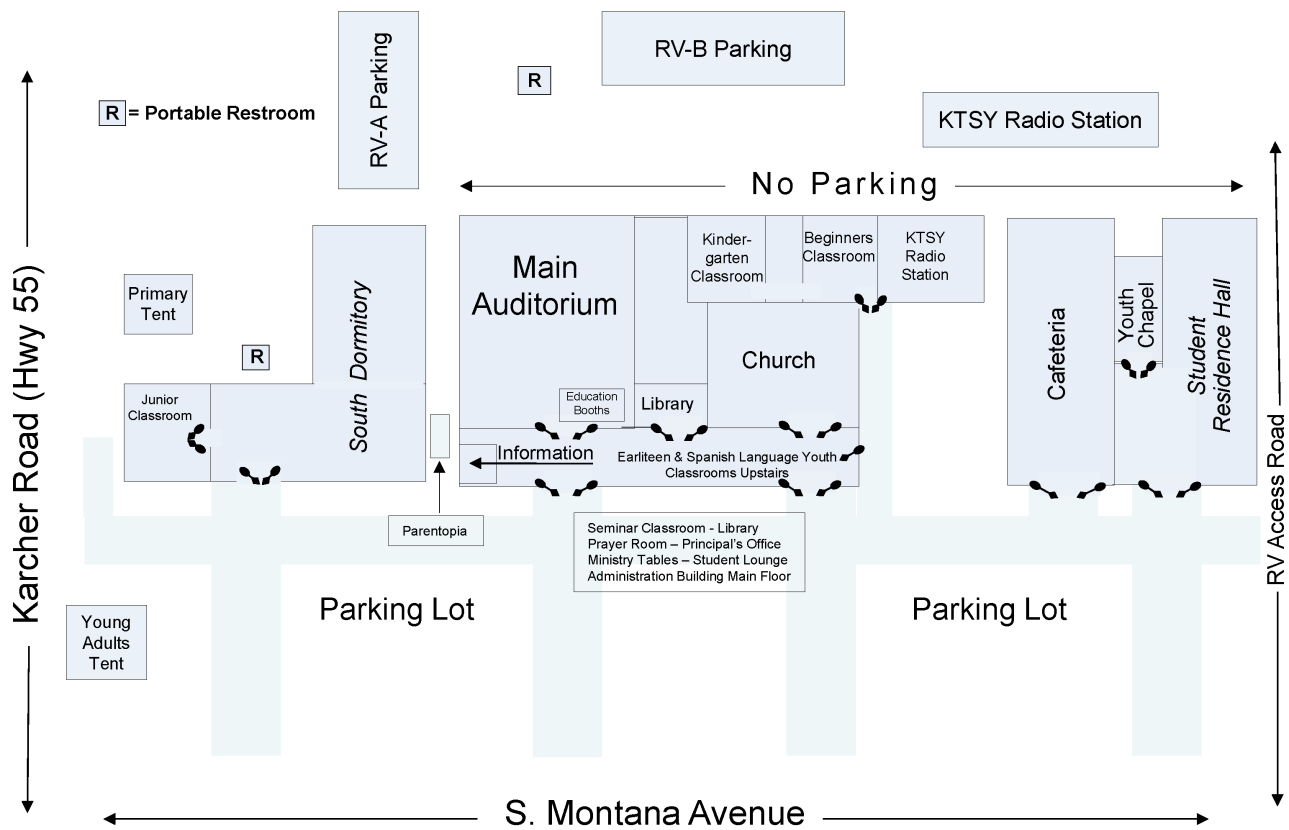
Please Note

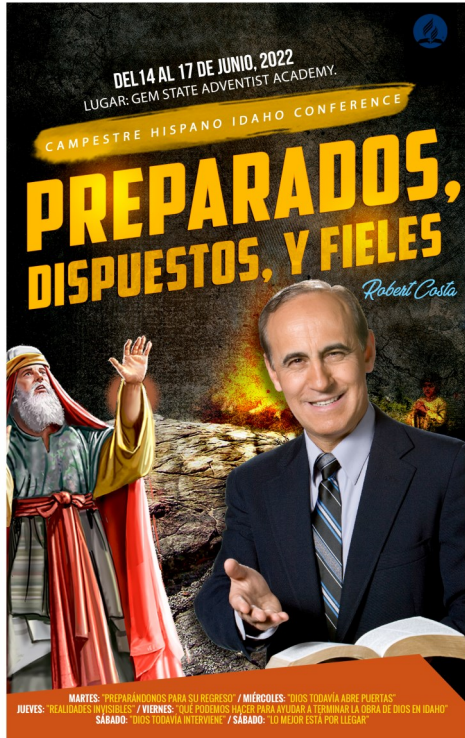
